The Rotary Club of Ashburn, Virginia is pleased to welcome Rotarian Colleen Bonadonna. Colleen is one of several hundred volunteers travel from around the world to join in the global fight to eradicate polio. These volunteers - all members of Rotary, administer the drops of oral polio vaccine to children, deliver the vaccine to remote villages and educate families on the importance of protecting children against polio. In February 2010, Colleen traveled to India to help with this tremendous program and will be heading back to India in January 2011 to continue with efforts to end Polio.

Colleen is a retired National Account Manager from Solvay Pharmaceutical. Active in Rotary, she is the immediate Past President Rotary Club of West Point, a RLI Faculty Member and District Chair for Clean Water & Sanitation
