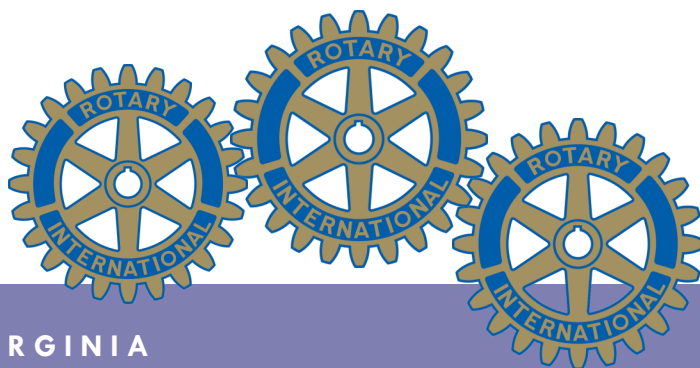

Welcome, Chamber CEO Tony Howard

Tony Howard is the President and CEO of the Loudoun County Chamber of Commerce, a 1,200-member business organization that is Northern Virginia's largest chamber of commerce.

Tony began his tenure as the Chief Executive of Loudoun's premier business networking and advocacy organization on August 1, 2006, after seven years at the Fairfax County Chamber of Commerce, where he last served as Chief Operating Officer and as Vice President of Membership and Communications.

Before joining the Fairfax County Chamber, Tony Howard served as the chief spokesman for Congressman Michael P. Forbes of New York, where he handled all media relations, working with major news outlets in New York City, Washington, D.C., and the East End of Long Island.

A graduate of the State University of New York, Tony is also an award-winning journalist, having worked as a reporter and editor for newspapers in New York's Hudson Valley and Long Island. Howard's journalism career earned him numerous awards for in-depth reporting, feature writing and sports coverage from his peers in the New York Press Association.

Tony Howard currently serves on a number of non-profit and professional boards, including the Board of Directors for the Loudoun Convention and Visitors Association, the Committee For Dulles, the Loudoun Small Business Development Center, the Loudoun County VALOR Foundation and the Virginia Association of Chamber of Commerce Executives. He is also a volunteer for the March For Dimes in Loudoun County and with Cub Scout Pack 958 of Leesburg.

A resident of Leesburg, Tony and his wife Alison have one son, Jake.

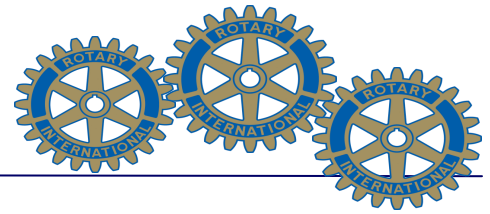
