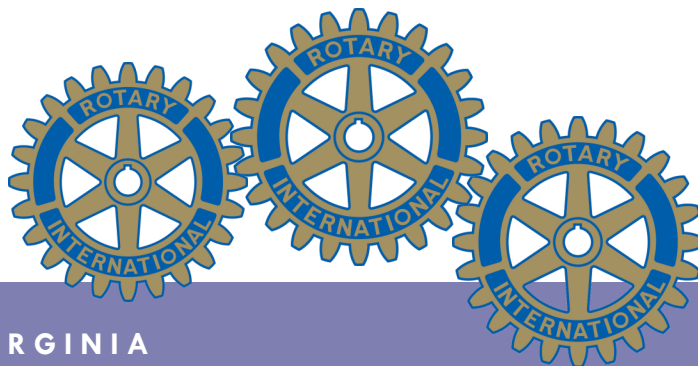

Ashburn Welcomes Chuck Davidson District Rotary Foundation Chair

Chuck Davidson has been a Rotarian for 41 years, joining the Rotary Club of East El Paso, Texas in 1970 and serving as its president in 1976-77. After a job reassignment, Chuck joined the Springfield, Virginia, Rotary Club in 1977, serving twice as President of that club in 1985-86 and 2001-02. During his years with Springfield Rotary, he instituted "Helping Hands" seminars for Springfield area immigrants, established trade school scholarships, and included senior citizens at club-sponsored theater fund-raising performances.

At the district level, Chuck completed three terms as Assistant Governor, two years as District Trainer, and chaired a number of district committees. His task force service included preparation of the first-ever District 7610 Strategic Plan and District 7610 Leadership Plan and Procedures Manual. In 2008-09, Chuck served as Governor of Rotary District 7610's 52 clubs. Currently, Chuck is the District Rotary Foundation Chair.

Born in Illinois in 1937, Chuck graduated from The Citadel in 1959 with a B.S. in Chemistry, and from Florida State University in 1962 with a Ph.D. in Nuclear Chemistry. Including two years as an Army officer, he spent 42 years in Government service, culminating as Director of the U.S. Army Nuclear and Chemical Agency. Chuck was a charter member of the Senior Executive Service.

Chuck resides with his wife Nita, also a Paul Harris Fellow and Major Donor, in Mason Neck, Virginia. They have three sons and two grandsons

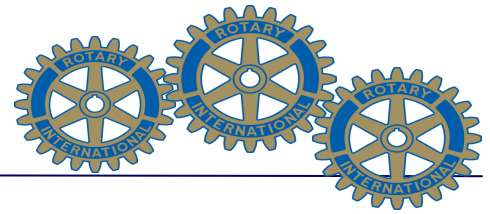
