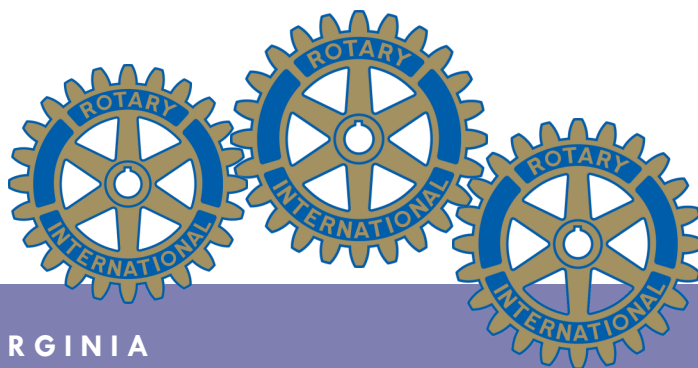

Jeff Dee, Executive Director of Habitat for Humanity to Speak

On Thursday, February 23 to Jeff Dee, Executive Director of Habitat for Humanity will join the Ashburn Rotary for lunch and to share the latest from Habitat for Humanity. Jeff Dee, the first Executive Director for Loudoun Habitat for Humanity, has been with the organization for almost a year and a half. Prior to that, he taught religion at a Catholic

High School both in Maine and Maryland for a total of nine years. While he was teaching, he served as a Camp Director at a Boy Scout Camp during the summers in New Hampshire. An Eagle Scout, Jeff has many years of experience with volunteering, leading service trips to places such as the Mississippi Delta Region or southeast Kentucky, and educating people on the value of giving back to the community.

Loudoun Habitat for Humanity, founded in 1993, is committed to eradicating poverty housing in Loudoun County. Since our founding, we have built or rehabilitated 20 houses in locations such as Leesburg, Sugarland Run, Village of St. Louis, Lovettsville, Purcellville and more. We look forward to many exciting projects in the future that will make an impact on the issue of affordable housing in Loudoun County.
