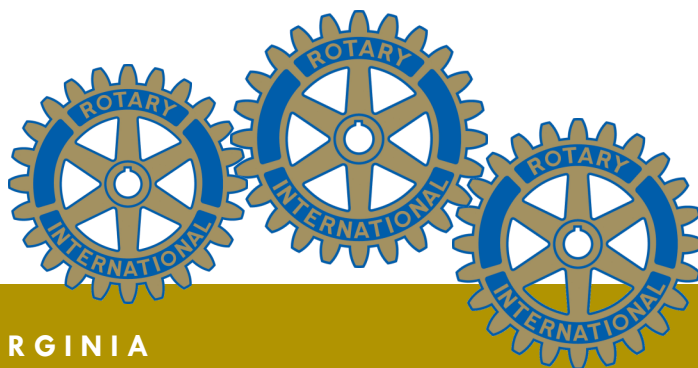

Ken Falke, a 21-year combat veteran of the U.S. Navy and retired Master Chief Petty Officer, is highly respected around the world and throughout the military and civilian anti- and counter- terrorism communities as an innovative and forward thinking leader in training and technology development.

Ken serves as a subject matter expert for the Department of Defense, the Department of State, the Department of Justice, and the Department of Homeland Security and many foreign governments. He routinely speaks at seminars on the subjects of anti- and counter-terrorism. He has training experience as a “hands on instructor” at both U.S. Naval EOD School and the Defense EOD School in Chattenden, England.

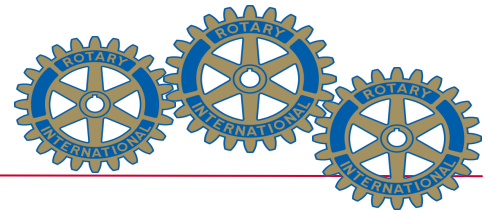
The Four-Way Test
