Michael J. Mallach, US State Department, Bureau of Diplomatic Security Visits the Rotary Club of Ashburn.

Born, raised and educated in Chicago, Illinois, Michael J. Mallach served in the US Navy 1962-1970. Mallach attended Hospital Corps School at Great lakes, Illinois, serving aboard the Aircraft Carrier USS Franklin D. Roosevelt and Helicopter Combat Support Squadron 4, Lakehurst, NJ. In 1966, Mallach attended Field Medical Service School, Marine Corps Base, Camp Pendleton, Ca., where he received training in combat medicine and was further transferred to the 3rd Marine Division, FMF, Viet Nam. Mallach served thirteen months with US Marine Corps combat units in Viet Nam participating in 21 combat operations. Mallach served 18 months at Naval Air Station, Jacksonville, Fl. where he was promoted to E-6 and received certification as an Independent Duty Hospital Corpsman. Mallach served aboard a Naval Destroyer, USS Forrest Sherman, as senior medical Department Representative and was honorably discharged in 1970.

From 1970-1994, Mallach served the Metropolitan Police Department, District of Columbia where he was assigned to the First Police District and later to the Special Operations Division where he retired in 1994.

Since 1997, Mallach has worked for the US Department of State, Bureau of Diplomatic Security where he is assigned to the Office of Domestic Operations, Domestic Facilities Protection, which is responsible for access control and operational security for approximately 119 domestic facilities.

In 1991, Mallach married his wonderful wife Linda, and gained an amazingly talented, smart and beautiful step-daughter, Jodi.
