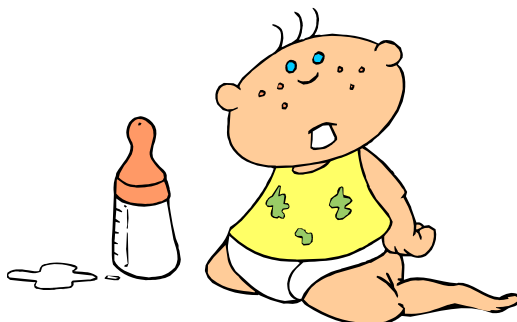
Free School Physicals Day at Loudoun Community Health Center:

The Bare Facts About Diapers... Did you know?

- Infants need up to 12 diapers per day & toddlers need about 8 diapers a day.
- An adequate supply of disposable diapers can cost more than \$100 a month.
- In low-income households, babies often spend a day or more in a single diaper.
- Inadequate diaper changing increases the risk of numerous health problems.
- Low income parents may not be able to benefit from free or subsidized childcare because they must leave disposable diapers at the childcare centers. This can lead to work and school absences among the caregivers.
- A baby crying from being in a soiled diaper for prolonged periods of time may be at a higher risk of physical abuse by a caregiver, as evidenced in studies of patterns of abuse among low-income families.
- An adequate supply of diapers for infants & children is considered a 'basic human need'.

- 4) Will it be BENEFICIAL to all concerned?"

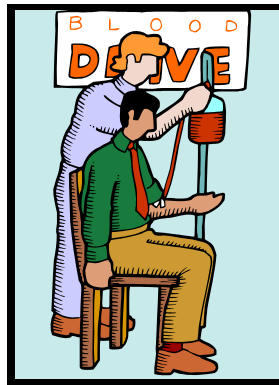


School and Office Supplies Needed for LAWS
