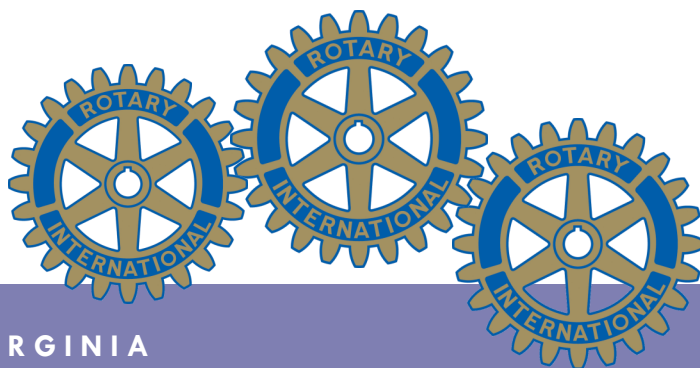

Superintendent Edgar B. Hatrick to Speak

Edgar B. Hatrick III has served as superintendent in Loudoun County since 1991. His entire career in education, which began in 1967, has been spent with Loudoun County Public Schools (LCPS). Previously, he was assistant superintendent for planning and pupil services (1987-91); director of instruction (1983-87); foreign language supervisor (1983-87); guidance supervisor (1984-88); director of special education (1978-83); principal of Loudoun County High School (1975-78); assistant principal of Broad Run High School (1970-75); chair of the English Department at Broad Run (1969-70); and an English teacher at Loudoun County High School. He served as president of the Virginia Association of School Superintendents and the Washington Area Superintendents' Study Council. He has been a guest lecturer at University of Virginia, George Mason University, Shenandoah University and Marymount University. He received his doctorate and master's degrees in education from Virginia Tech and his bachelor's degree in English from the University of Richmond.



Hatrick is a 1963 graduate of Loudoun County High School.

He has been a member of the American Association of School Administrators (AASA) for 23 years and has served on the AASA Executive Committee and the AASA Governing Board as well as serving as its president for the 2010-2011 school year.

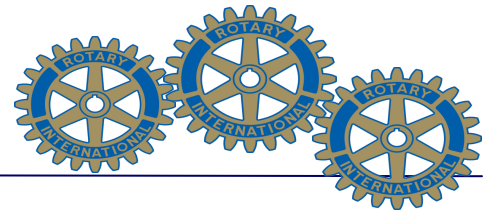
