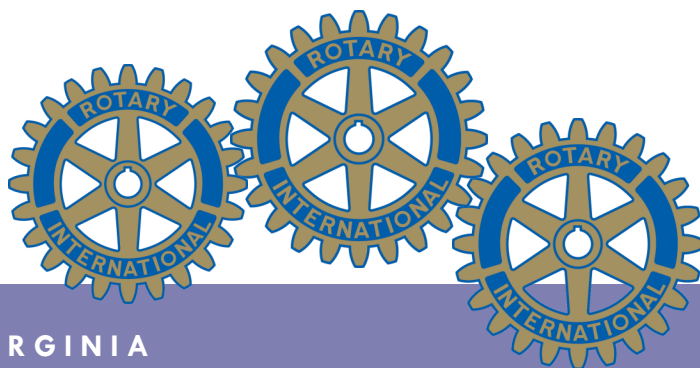

During his career, Sheriff Simpson has obtained extensive experience in every area of law enforcement to include Corrections, Communications, Criminal Investigations, Field Training, Patrol and Administration.



Sheriff Simpson attended the Annandale Campus of the Northern Virginia Community College majoring in Police Science. He also attended the Northern Virginia Criminal Justice Academy, completing numerous management and other specialized courses. He also has completed the Law Enforcement Executive Development Seminar at the F.B.I. Academy in Quantico, VA, and the Virginia Sheriffs' Institute Chief Executive Training.

He belongs to numerous professional and civic organizations. He has served as the Chairman of the Council of Governments Corrections Chiefs Committee, and is currently a member of the Northern Virginia Criminal Justice Academy's Executive Committee, the National Sheriffs' Association's Highway Safety Committee, the Victim Services Committee, and is currently the Secretary of the Virginia Sheriffs' Association and serves on its Board of Directors.

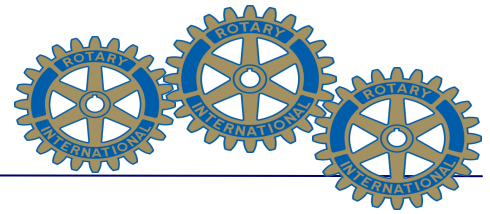
