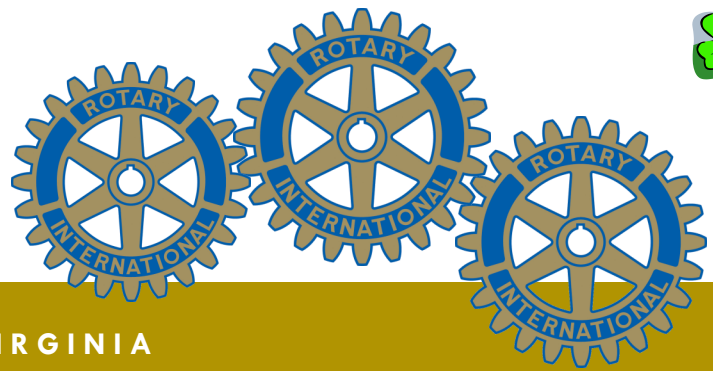

Nancy is now the Regional Manager for Programs and Services with the National Capital Area Chapter of the Alzheimer's Association and oversees Programs and Services in Fairfax, Loudoun, Clarke, Frederick, Warren and Rappahannock counties. Nancy takes great pride in mentoring students and raising awareness of the disease.

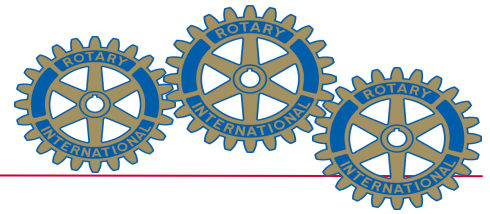
