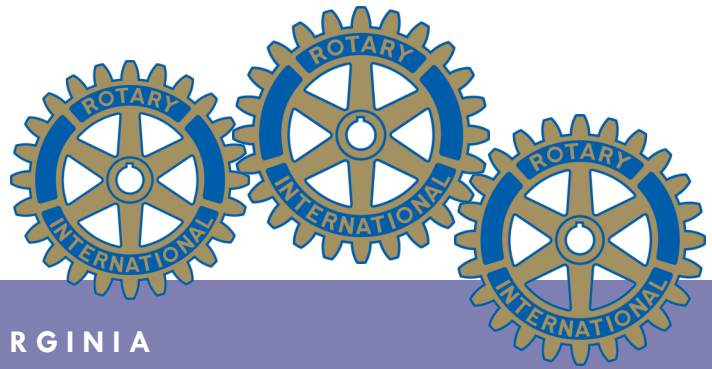

## Ashburn Welcomes Tracee Lydia Garner, Outreach Coordinator with Loudoun ENDependence.

Tracee Lydia Garner is Virginia native and long-time resident of Loudoun County. She is a graduate of Old Dominion University with a BS in Communication. She has worn many hats including one as a national best-selling and award winning author. As a public speaker she has facilitated workshops, conferences and other events with the likes of Martin Luther King, III, former secretary of labor, Alexis Herman, former Assistant Secretary for the Office of Special Education, Judy Heumann, and been a guest for the radio show *On A Roll*, with founder and host Greg Smith, a live weekly syndicated commercial radio talk show on life and disability.

Currently, Tracee is the Outreach Coordinator for Loudoun ENDependence (LEND) and has also served on the Loudoun County Disability Services Board, the Board of Directors for Coalition for Housing Opportunities In the Community for Everyone (CHOICE), a non-profit organization focusing on advancing affordable, accessible housing options for people with disabilities throughout Northern Virginia. She is a Leadership Loudoun class of 2011 alumni and current board member. As Outreach Coordinator at Loudoun ENDependence she manages a small caseload, while working on county, regional and grassroots advocacy efforts, media, marketing and fundraising, grant writing and overall assist all people with disabilities and their families in overcoming employment barriers, healthcare access, higher education pursuits, and has made significant impacts on increased transportation options in Loudoun. She was instrumental in assisting LEND with obtaining the seed money to open the center's doors and two years later became a full time employee and has helped the organization gain increased visibility in the community.

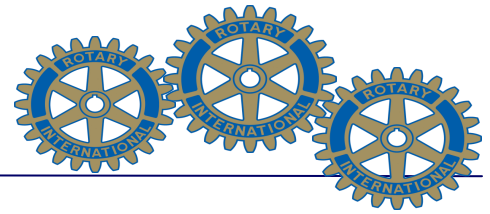
