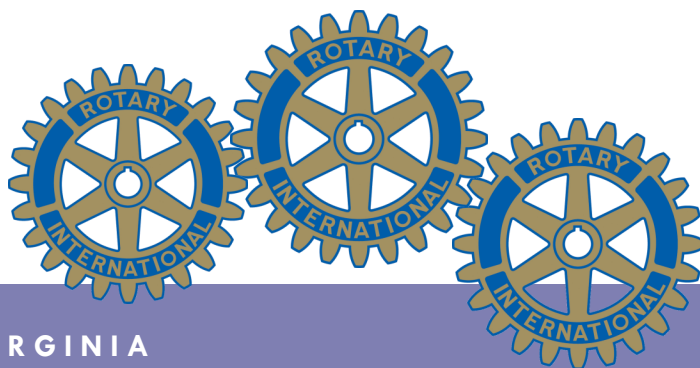

Kaler has also served as executive director of the Lake Tahoe Visitors Authority/Tahoe Douglas Visitors Authority/Lake Tahoe Gaming Alliance; Great Lakes of North America; and the Galena/Jo Daviess County Convention & Visitors Bureau; and has held senior positions with Keeshin Destination Chicago and the Champaign-Urbana Convention & Visitors Bureau. He holds a Master of Science degree in tourism from the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign, and a Bachelor of Science degree in recreation, parks, and tourism administration from Western Illinois University. 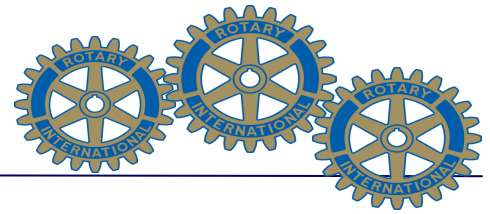
