Dustin Holliday, Director of Outreach for Christian Fellowship Church to Speak

The Rotary Club of Ashburn, VA is pleased to welcome Dustin Holliday, Director of Outreach for Christian Fellowship Church. Since Feb 2007, Holliday, working with the members of CFC, has developed CFC's vision, mission and strategies aimed at serving others locally and globally. Among CFC's many-faceted mission, the Holliday has pioneered efforts in Nicaragua where a holistic plan has been implemented to assist three communities near Puerto Cabezas, Nicaragua.

Since 2006, Holliday has served as a board member of the ORPHANetwork. As a Business Development Consultant, with the ORPHANetwork, holiday works in Nicaragua with partner communities of Orphanetwork to develop viable small business plans that can be presented to U.S. donors for funding and loans for capital. Once funded, Holliday consults on the actual implementation and management during the repayment period.

Holliday is also part owner of PEACE Corporation (Nicaragua). Through partnership with Nicaraguans, a for-profit charitable business was incorporated to generate money to fund various community development initiatives within Nicaragua. PEACE Corporation also provides a platform for employing locals and job training.

In addition to his work with CFC, ORPHANetwork and PEACE Corporation, Holliday worked in law enforcement for ten years between 1997-2007, working in Fairfax County and the City of Lakewood, Colorado. Holliday graduated from George Mason University in 1997 with a BS in Management.

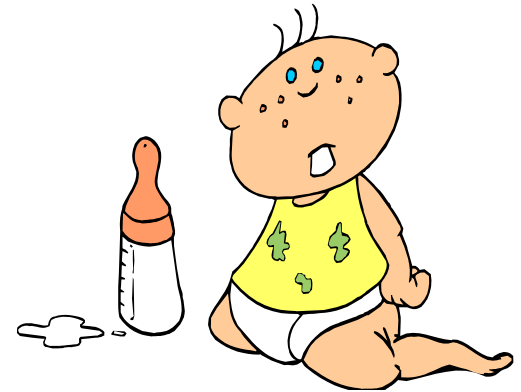
- 1) Is it the TRUTH?
