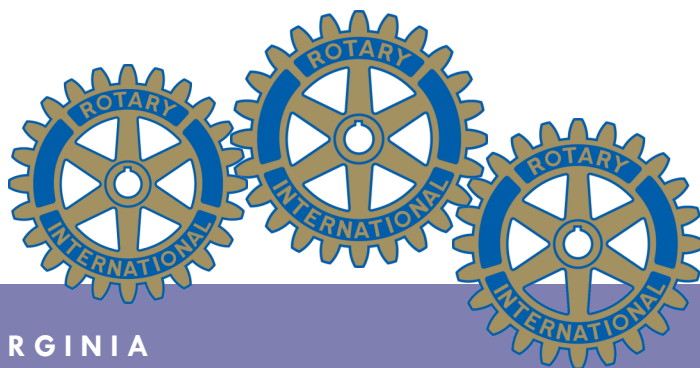

Randy Sutliff Claude Moore Foundation to Speak

On Thursday, May 31, Randy Sutliff, Deputy Executive Director of Operations for the Claude Moore Charitable Foundation, will speak before the Rotary Club of Ashburn. Involved in the Claude Moore properties since the 1980's, Sutliff has been active in regional planning in the Dulles area, Fairfax and Loudoun Counties. Sutliff's work has focused on the Moorefield Station area beginning with initial planning in the 1990s, rezoning in 2002, and continues with the ongoing development process.

Growing up in Richmond, Sutliff attended Notre Dame, Following college, he served as an officer in the Coast Guard for three years stationed in Tidewater. Sutliff returned to school and obtained his law degree at Georgetown, while working part-time at the predecessor to McCandlish & Lillard in Fairfax. As an associate with the firm, Sutliff and continued his studies, earning a Masters in Tax Law. Sutliff became a principal with the law firm, then its President. The firm joined offices with with Miles & Stockbridge, where he was a partner and Virginia practice manager until the practices separated in 1995. He was again President of McCandlish & Lillard until going on Senior Status in 2007, and will be retiring from the law practice this summer.

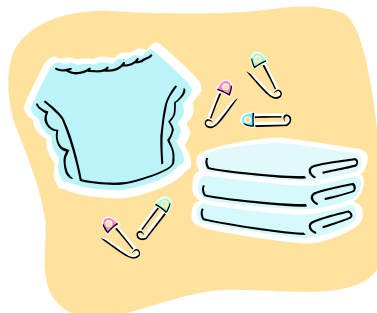

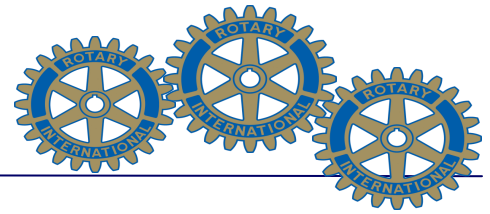
