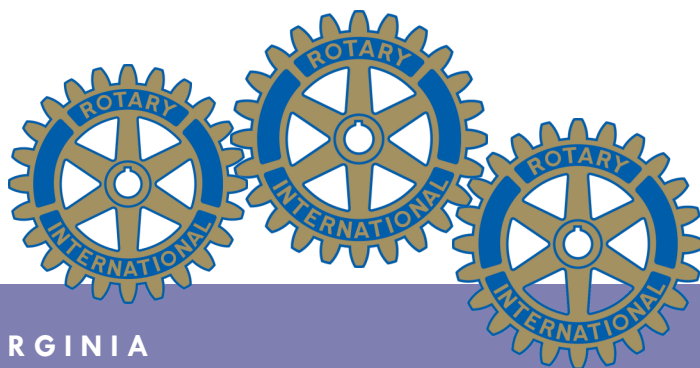

Andy Johnston, Loudoun Cares Executive Director to Speak

Andy Johnston has been the Executive Director of Loudoun Cares, a 501c3 nonprofit charity based in Leesburg, VA, since its founding in 2003. In this capacity he has developed programs and initiatives to strengthen the local nonprofit sector. These include the local Information & Referral Telephone Helpline and the Claude Moore Community Builders program which trains and coordinates placements of high school youth for volunteer opportunities with local nonprofits. In 2010 Loudoun Cares realized the first phase of a long time dream when four nonprofit agencies occupied the Loudoun Cares Nonprofit Center. He now leads a \$2.5 million dollar effort to renovate an additional 10,000 sq ft of the building to provide for even more nonprofit office and conference/training space.

Andy is a member of the Nonprofit Centers Network Steering Committee and a passionate advocate for the development of nonprofit infrastructure in Loudoun County and throughout the country and internationally. He also serves as Chairman of the Loudoun Human Services Network, a collaboration of health and human service nonprofits working to strengthen nonprofits and the services they provide to Loudoun families. Andy was one of the founding members of Loudoun Interfaith Bridges, an association of faith communities working together to Build Relationships for Interfaith Dialogue, Goodwill, Education and Service. The group now includes Christians, Jews, Muslims, Sikhs, Ba'hai, Quakers, Unitarians and more.

Last year Andy was named Citizen of the Year and a Paul Harris Fellow by Leesburg Daybreak Rotary.

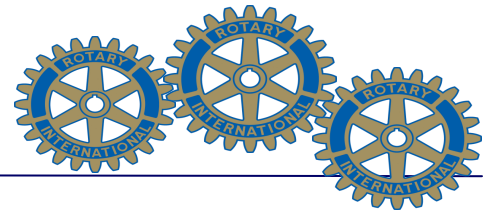
