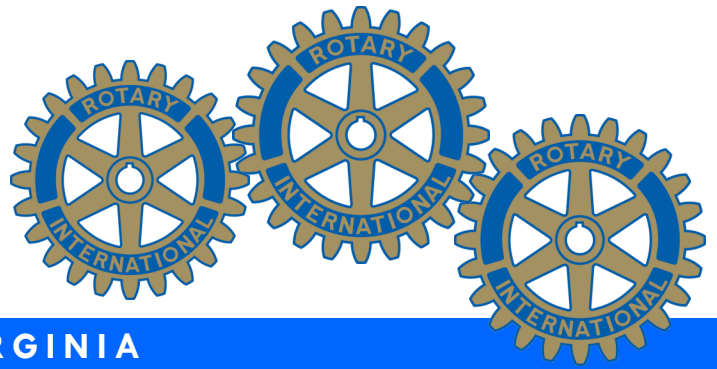

Dave Norman will speak about *Imagine* on Thursday, November 14.



Dave Norman is the founding pastor of Crossroads United Methodist Church. For the past 24 years Dave has guided the Crossroads community to have a heart for both those inside and outside the walls of the church. Whether it is connecting through acts of service or casual conversations Crossroads believes the mission of the church is to engage with people regardless of their belief or lack of.

In 2011 Dave, along with members of Crossroads, helped to lead the congregation in a process known as Human Design Thinking. Instead of starting a new faith community in the normal way wherein we go in believing we know what the community needs, Human Design Thinking takes the approach of listening first and then responding.

Crossroads interviewed 50 people who are disconnected from any religious institution to listen and learn about their lives, their likes and dislikes, their dreams and passions, their, hopes and fears and how they might want to connect communally and spiritually.

Out of this process was born a movement called Imagine. Imagine gives a framework for people to gather in bars, restaurants, yoga studios, homes or wherever is appropriate to engage with people where they are in spiritual conversation and community.

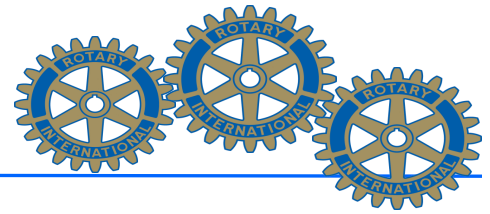
