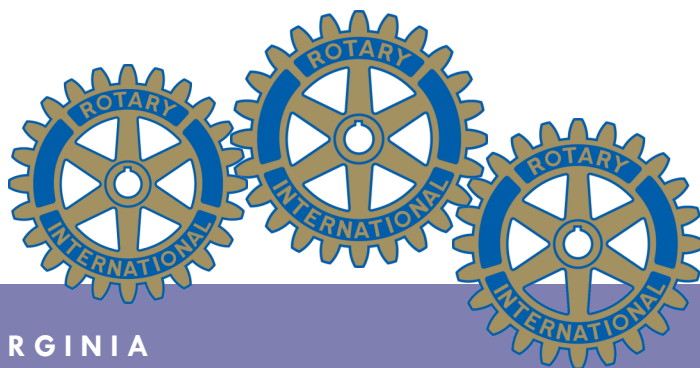

POLIO NURSING...

PRIOR TO THE SALK & SABIN VACCINES

The Rotary Club of Ashburn, Virginia is pleased to welcome Jody Zogran RN, BS, to its Club Meeting on Thursday, November 18. During her presentation, Jody will explain the nursing techniques that were used during the polio epidemic that occurred in Western Pennsylvania in the mid 1950's. Jody illustrates her presentation using Power Point. The presentation may be 25 minutes to one hour, depending on time availability. She will include a description of how she worked with the Iron Lung, Rocking Bed, and the Monahan Lung. Her presentation will emphasize the importance of the Rotary Polio Plus program in alleviating suffering throughout the world.
