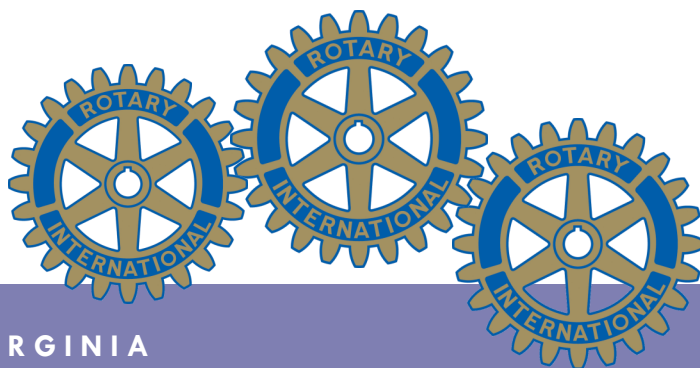

Jason Pettrey is the Global Analyst for ExxonMobil's Supply and Transportation division in Fairfax, Virginia. He received his degree in chemical engineering from Virginia Tech in 2002, after completing several co-op terms in refining, polymers and chemical manufacturing at ExxonMobil's Gulf Coast facilities.



In 2002, Jason started his full-time career with ExxonMobil in Baytown, Texas, working a series of assignments as a process engineer and then as a coordinator in the Baytown Complex. Later roles included a technical section supervisor position in 2006, followed by a process section supervisor role in 2008, managing Baytown Refinery's crude and delayed coking operating units. Jason recently relocated from Texas to Virginia for his current role in industry analysis.

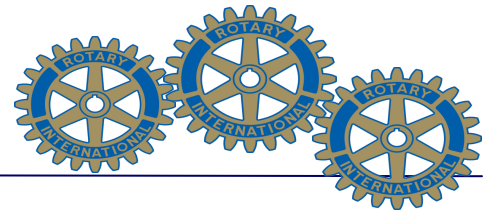

- 4) Will it be BENEFICIAL to all concerned?"

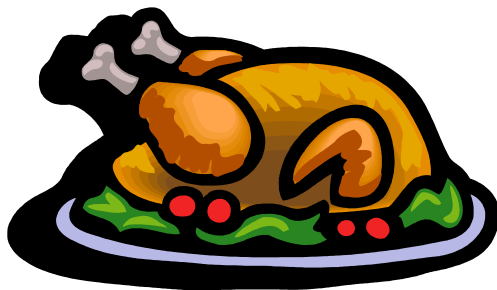


Thanksgiving Basket Collection Continues
