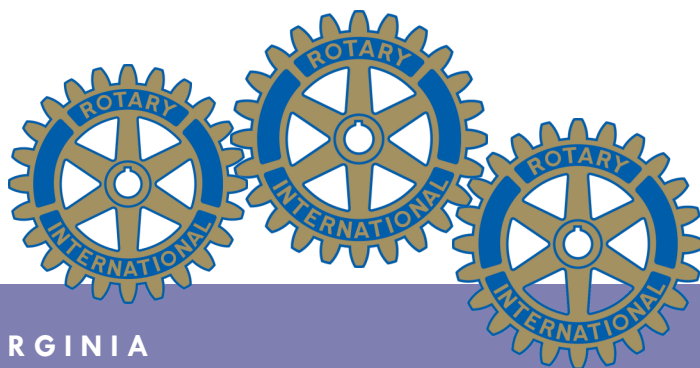

10th District Congressional District Candidate Barnett to Speak

Jeff Barnett, the Democratic Candidate for Virginia's 10th District will speak to the Rotary Club of Ashburn.

Jeff Barnett is a father, husband, military veteran, corporate planner and accomplished author. A graduate of the College of Holy Cross in Worcester, Massachusetts, Barnett majored in history and was active in student government. Jeff was also the cadet commander of Air Force ROTC. Following graduation in 1972, Barnett followed in his father's footsteps by going straight to Air Force flight school.



Following 26 years of distinguished service, Barnett retired from the United States Air Force as a full Colonel. He spent the next four years as a government consultant with Booz-Allen-Hamilton in McLean.

In 2003, Barnett joined Toffler Associates, the international executive advisory firm founded by world-renowned futurist Alvin Toffler. Barnett advised corporate and government leaders on how to lead their organizations in the information age. During this time, Barnett wrote his second book, The Job Box. This book helps young people understand their constantly changing job.

Barnett is very proud that both his children answered the call to service. Marit serves as an Army Doctor at Walter Reed Medical Center. Courtney is currently deployed to Afghanistan as a member of the Air Force 41st Electronic Combat Squadron.

Barnett lives with his wife Katherine in McLean.

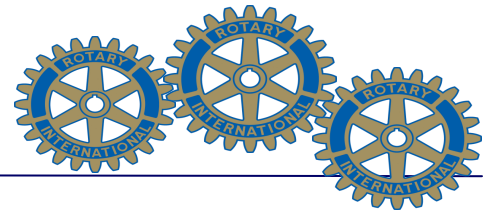
