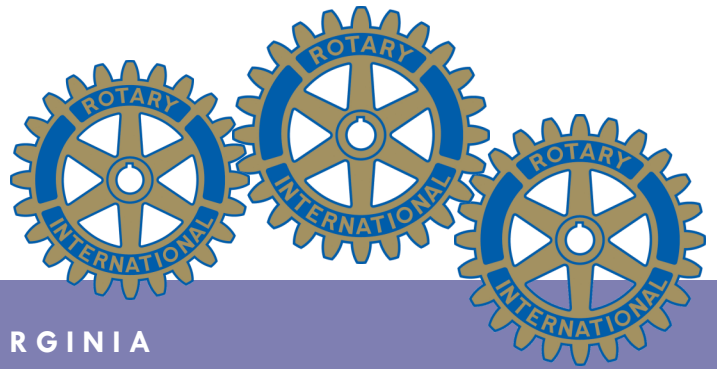

Ashburn Rotary Welcomes Supervisor Andrea McGimsey

Andrea McGimsey currently serves Loudoun County on the Board of Supervisors representing the Potomac District. After the 2010 census and the resulting changes in districts, Andrea is running for reelection as the incumbent in the new Broad Run District.

Andrea serves on the Board's Transportation and Land Use Committee. She chaired the Board's Energy and Environment Committee and served on the Public Safety and Human Services Committee for two years.

She currently represents Loudoun County on the Board of Directors of the Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments (COG), the COG Climate, Energy, and Environment Policy Committee, the Board of Directors of the Dulles Area Transportation Association (DATA), and the Route 28 Transportation Improvement District Commission. She also serves on the Executive Committee of Climate Communities, the Environment, Energy and Land Use Steering Committee of the National Association of Counties, and as the Vice Chair of the Transportation Steering Committee of the Virginia Association of Counties.

She was born in Alexandria and raised in Springfield, Virginia. She earned a Bachelor of Science degree from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology and a master's degree in interactive telecommunications from New York University.

She is the executive director of Oatlands, a National Trust for Historic Preservation site south of Leesburg on Route 15. From 1998 to 2003, she worked for America Online in strategic development.

In 2004, while working for the Piedmont Environmental Council, she founded and directed the Campaign for Loudoun's Future, a coalition of 17 local groups. She is a former member of the Sterling Volunteer Fire Company and received the 2003 Administrative Member of the Year Award and the 2008 Outstanding Service to Our Community Award.
