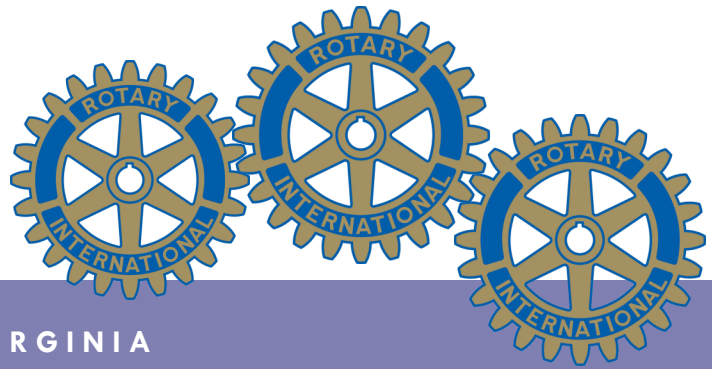

Born and raised in Loudoun County, Virginia, W. Keith Brower was selected to serve as the Chief of the Loudoun County Department of Fire, Rescue and Emergency Management in November 2010 following a nationwide search. With more than 25 years of service with the Loudoun County Department of Fire, Rescue and Emergency Management, Brower has seen many changes to Loudoun's fire and rescue system. He has a proven record with both career and volunteer personnel and is committed to enhancing Loudoun's combination system.



Brower's passion for fire-rescue began in 1973, when following in his father's footsteps, he joined the Purcellville Volunteer Fire Company. While in college, he ran with the Bridgewater Volunteer Fire Department while in college. In 1978, he was hired by Fairfax County Fire Department. Following 6 years with Fairfax County, Brower was hired by Loudoun County as the Chief of Training and Operations for Loudoun County Fire and Rescue in 1984. In 1988 he was promoted to Assistant Director. Between 2004 and 2010, Brower served as the Chief Fire Marshal for Loudoun.

Brower is a member of the Purcellville Rotary has served a variety of offices including vice president of the Club.

A graduate of Loudoun Valley High School, Brower is the fourth generation to be born and raised in Loudoun. In May 1978, Brower graduated from Bridgewater College.

Brower and his wife of nearly 30 years Cheryl make their home in Lovettsville. They have three sons, Dan (25), Rob (23), and Ben (18).

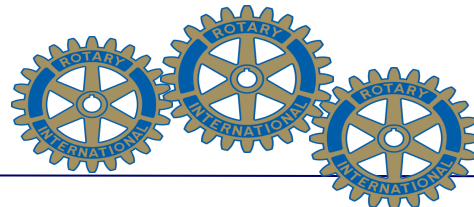

- 4) Will it be BENEFICIAL to all concerned?"

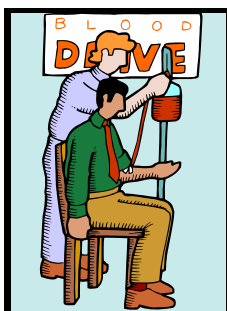


Reminders:
