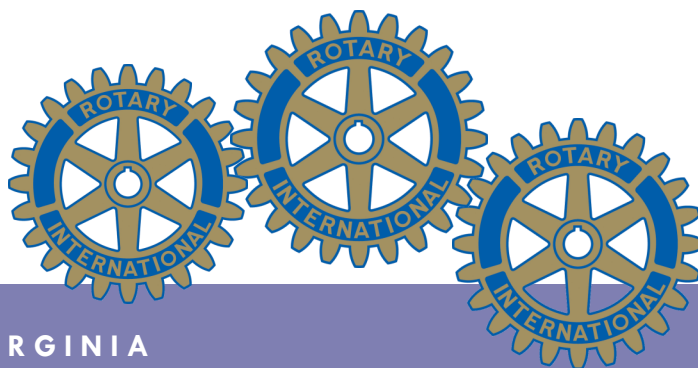

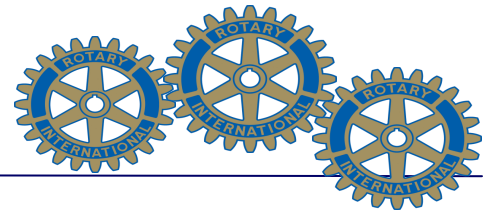

The Four-Way Test

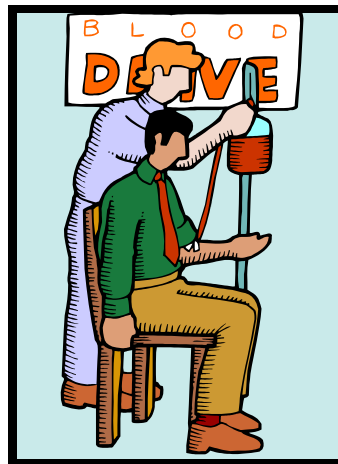
