for the Later day Saints of Laie. They manage 6700 acres in Laie and Kahuku-Malae' Kahana. In 2003 & 4 they acquired an additional 900 acres from Campbell Estates and 14,000 acres from Kualoa to Turtle Bay. They have 4,000 acres on

the church property in Laie which has a 2700 student body. The Mormon Temple was built in 1919 and the University began as the Church College of Hawaii in 1955. In 2010 a new hotel began developed. PCC in 2007 - 2008 reached over 1,000,000 visitors but dropped in 2009 to present. Concerns are the housing and job markets for the residence. Family income averages \$5400 a year. Most of the houses in the area not on church property are owned by absentee owners not living in Hawaii. There was a survey of the current residence with over 650 participants. They want more growth that they can control, Labor and housing are needed and how to balance economics, cultural issues. The student at BYU Hawaii College are from 24 different countries.

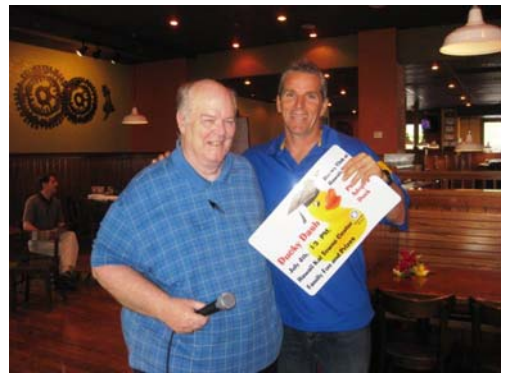
