President Nick Abbott brought the meeting to order. His first subject was the Rotary Foundation and how to increase membership. Without additional members we cannot increase our contributions. Henry DeButts gave us a Rotary Minute focused on the High School Interact Club. Our speaker was introduced after our Happy Dollars collection.



Martha Smith, COO of Kapiolani Medical Center for Women and Children. KMCWC's mission is to advocate for the health and well being of the women and children of Hawaii and the Pacific Basin. KMCWC is a non profit hospital funded on Philanthropy. They are on of 4 hospitals in Hawaii Pacific Health. Last year , they provided \$42.9 million to the community in terms of reimbursement shortfalls, education, specialty services and teaching and research. KMCWC is compared to the very best hospitals on the mainland and better than 90% of their standards. Construction projects are focused on a new parking garage now underway and will open February 2013, Technology, Creating Family Space and Education. The goal is to create private rooms for ICU's, allowing parents to stay and participate in the care and healing of their children. NICU goes from a 46 bed open unit to 70 private rooms. New dining, education space and lobby are planned. The project is estimated at \$160 million. The Philanthropy team is raising 430 million, and just passed \$20 million in one year.

Our DG Chet Dal Santo addressed the club briefly with emphasis on the upcoming Peace Conference in January. They will be collecting gifts to take on an around the world cruise of the Hokulea. The gifts will be given at each stop on their trip.
