Christine Sakuda addressed our club on the 4th with information regarding the medical technology and what her firm is working on to tie all medical patient files together from one medical service to another.

Christine represents the Hawaii Health Information Exchange. Incorporated in 2006,

a 501 (c)(3) Non Profit Organization. Their Goal is to organize how medical care is administered.

Physicians of Hawaii typically have all paper work on patients in their offices rather than in a data base. Better communication through technology increases patient safety and Health Care costs are better controlled.

Patients are reluctant to share information due to problems they have seen through the financial institutions. To alleviate these concerns, the state controls the information shared and the medical field does not have financial information as banks do. Their only interest is in health care and financial positions of health care.

Trying to organize a technical infrastructure to help physicians implement health records between different medical facilities is very involved as there are over 30 different electronic systems which do not communicate with each other. The Hawaii Health information Exchange is working to get all electronic systems to communicate with each other.

Developing a technology Information Structure that is secure, governed by the State enabled by your primary care provider, the neighborhood pharmacy, any labs used and hospitals to share information provides better information. Now most of this information is on paper and not easily accessible.



Rick Zagar of the District Rotary Foundation addressed our club prior to our schedule speaker. He discussed the Permanent Fund of the Rotary Foundation funded by your cash donations or by bequests. Bequests are the most common form of contributions. The funds are never spent but the interest earned

by the fund is distributed on the same basis as annual giving funds. 50% is retained by the World Fund to support Foundation projects. 50% goes back to
