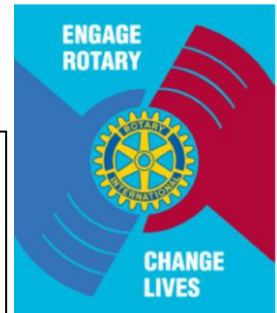

### Meeting – with the Governer

The Governor of WA, Malcolm McCusker AO CVO QC, addressed the Bunbury combined Rotary Clubs honoured at a combined meeting of clubs at the Lord Forrest Hotel on Friday 26 July, at a lunch time meeting.

Mr McCusker spoke on the subject of philanthropic giving. He himself has established the McCusker Charitable Foundation which has made grants of \$20 million, and is patron of some 200 charities in WA, including Rotary International.

He said he was reluctant to talk about his philanthropic work, but was persuaded by others to do so, in order to increase community levels of awareness and commitment to, giving.

He encouraged Rotary to let community know about its achievements, and to foster media cooperation to achieve this.

He said that various initiatives have helped receive good results.

Needs in WA of special concern include: children from disadvantaged homes, and Aboriginals.

On the subject of giving, he quoted Warren Buffett, that the perfect amount to leave children is "enough money so that they would feel they could do anything, but not so much that they could do nothing."

Member Ray Jordan presented the Governor ('Call me Your Highness' or 'call me Macka') Mr McCusker with a jarrah plaque inlaid with items including a penny (from the last year they were minted), a two-cent piece (first year of mint) and gold features. Thank your Ray for the uniquely Australian and Western Australian memento.
