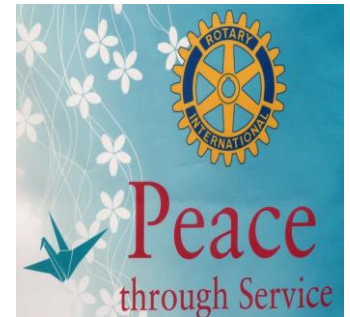

This week's meeting was a combined meeting with Rotary clubs from Bunbury, partners and members from the public, in particular, the local Orchid society. All gathered to listen to the amazing search for extinct orchids in Peru by Dr Henry Oakeley.

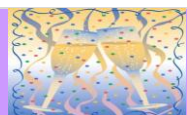


In what could only be described as a modern day Indiana Jones, Dr Oakeley mesmerized us with his fluent and eloquent Latin names for orchids, descriptions of the diversified and often contrasting environments in which they grow and his search for *Anguloa Uni Flora*. A search that took him to places where no man has been for 100s of years, with narrow roads meandering along cliff edges, deadly caterpillars, flea infested bedding and 3740m above sea level. MORE ABOUT DR HENRY OAKELEY'S SEARCH FOR ANGULOA UNI FLORA



Paul Cassidy , president of Bunbury Central, welcomed combined members, partners and special guests to the meeting. Adrian Barrett introduced Dr Oakeley.

Dr Oakeley explained that whilst new orchids were being discovered every year, his goals was to find extinct orchids. This desire took him to the lost city of the Icarus, the Andes, Huasahuasi, and finally central Peru. He only had sketches from 100 years ago, but people recognised the plant and recalled where they had seen it.

He saw many orchids along the way that showcased the diverse nature of the plant in terms, of size, colour, shape, smell, pollination techniques and climate. It was an entertaining night with many anecdotal comments about a diet of potato soup, making roads as they went along, rebuilding bridges and tracks that disappeared. Ben Andrew thanked Dr Oakeley with a Rotary Pin for the year of peace.

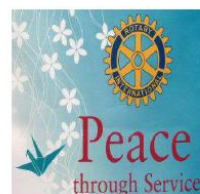
