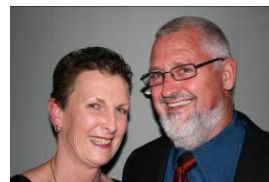

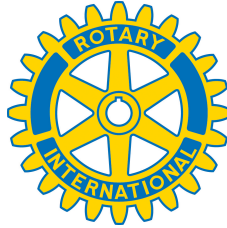

Nicole hails from Nelson, British Columbia in Canada. She was an exchange student in 2002-03 to Brussels in Belgium, learned French, and this whetted her appetite for international work. In 2005 she did voluntary work in Cambodia, and later Tanzania. In 2008 she was an exchange student to the University of Cape Town, to further her counselling studies. Her goal is a United Nations internship, and other work with the UN.
