Entry fee is \$10.00 per car

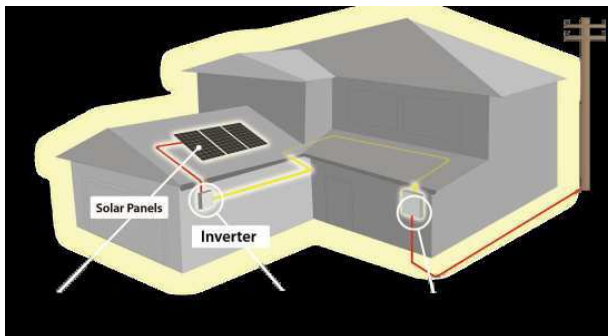

Spoke on Solar Power:

Solar Panels on your roof convert direct Sunlight into electricity, even on cloudy days.

The inverter converts DC Power from the solar panels to AC power for household use.
