“Media is important to society’s development”

“Media is important to society’s development” this was the main message outlined by the Speaker Daoud Kuttab, during his talk on “The importance of Media and Society” on August 14. The renowned speaker introduced the different types of media that exist and how important the media is to society and how dynamically it can help us all when it is controlled by society itself.

He further explained the distortions that are suffered by the media in terms of the Jordanian government ownership and management of the state-owned media rather than a freely oriented media like BBC. Kuttab criticized the lack of community participation in expressing their opinions on the future of the media in Jordan, although everyone agreed to its importance.

A broad discussion at the end of the lecture with a number of participants expressing their reservations regarding to freedom of expression, in addition to the importance and need to regulate the social media with regard to children and "bullying via the Internet".

Activities roundup

A permanent transit post established by Rotarians at Killa Abdullah, Balochistan, Pakistan, routinely immunizes more than 70 children per day. Staffed by two vaccinators, the post reaches children traveling from remote areas of Balochistan to Afghanistan. Strengthening routine immunization against polio is an objective of the [endgame strategic plan](#).

Rotary Scholar Robert Avery-Phipps of Nottingham, England, raised US\$1,700 by running in the Great Wall Marathon in China.

The [Rotary Club of Shanghai](#), China, sponsored a polio awareness event carried out by community volunteers at the China Pavilion, an iconic museum on the grounds of the 2010 Shanghai Expo. The event was part of an ongoing public awareness campaign and effort to raise funds through the sale of End Polio Now buttons.

A Thai dinner for Rotary Youth Exchange students, hosted by Derek Boulton of the Rotary Club of Greeley, Colorado, USA, and his wife, Stephanie, netted more than \$740.

Children in South Berwick, Maine, USA, raised \$530 for PolioPlus by selling lemonade and donated goods at a yard sale.
