## FOUNDATION TIP

*When Should you Send Donations to The Rotary Foundation?*

**First Quarter Donations, September 1st** - Gives time for any new Foundation Awards to be received before Foundation month in November.

**Second Quarter Donations, December 1st** - Gives time for the donation to be credited for the correct tax year (December 31st).

**Third Quarter Donations, March 1st** - Gives time for the donation to count in Share Our Success (call for recognition) and Presidential Citation deadline (March 31st).

**Fourth Quarter Donations, June 1st** - Gives time for the donation to be posted in the correct Rotary year (July 1 through June 30).
