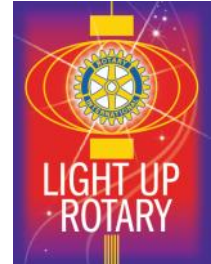

### PASSING THE BATON

It is not often that one would find yourself in an audience with seven or eight musical composers whilst you watch and listen to their works being performed - with some of the composers participating in those performances. This is what Hilary and I, along with a few hundred other people, experienced a few days ago at St Mary's Catholic Cathedral in Cape Town.

The concert was performed by the Cape Town Youth Choir (CTYC) and the Horizons Choir Project (HCP) from Pretoria (see <http://www.quicket.co.za/events/9624-ctyc-in-concert-with-the-horizons-project-choir/#/>). You will note from the link that the CTYC performed some compositions by Cape Town-based Peter Klatzow (born 1945) and Hendrik Hofmeyer (born 1957). The HCP, on the other hand, performed works by composers who are, probably, in the main, not older than 30 years.

The songs were sung mainly acapella, with minimal instrumental accompaniment for a few of them.

It was a unique experience to be present and to see the baton being passed - literally and figuratively - from the older generation to the younger in the same concert.

In closing, I would highly recommend the CTYC. A visit to their website ([www.ctyc.co.za](http://www.ctyc.co.za)) - where you can read about their international and local achievements as well as download some of their amazing music - is a really worthwhile experience. You won't regret it!

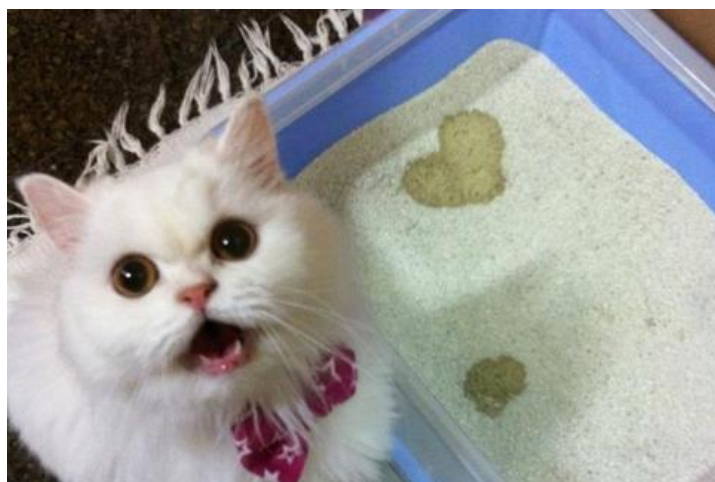
