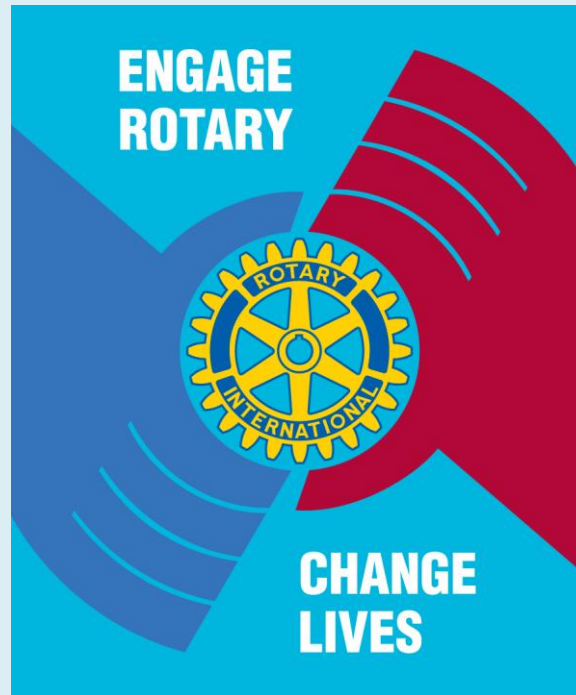

# What is the Paul Harris Society?



- Named after Rotary's founder, the Paul Harris Society recognizes those who annually contribute \$1,000.00 or more to the Annual Fund, PolioPlus, or an approved Rotary Foundation grant.
- By joining the Paul Harris Society, you are making a lasting difference in communities around the world.
- 3% of the eligible TRF supporters are eligible for the PHS. Their contributions represent 35% of all Annual Fund Contributions for the year.

# What is the Impact?



In 2012-2013; 36 Clubs within District 5240 joined forces to generate nearly \$160,000.00 to provide teacher training programs for over 1,000 pre-school teachers in Sri Lanka (District 3220). PHS contributions play a large role in the success of these types of projects.
