Polio Headlines:

April 7 marked one year since the onset of paralysis of the most recent case of wild poliovirus in the Middle East.

April 12 marked 60 years since Jonas Salk's inactivated polio vaccine (IPV) was launched, enabling children to be protected against polio for the first time.

National Immunization Days are planned in Madagascar on 27 April to 1 May.

Afghanistan: **No new cases of wild poliovirus type 1 (WPV1) have been reported in the past week.** The most recent case had onset of paralysis on 21 January in Reg district of Hilmand province. The total number of WPV1 cases for 2014 remains 28, and 1 for 2015. Most of the cases from 2014 were linked to cross-border transmission with neighboring Pakistan.

Nigeria: **No new case of WPV1 was reported in the past week.** Nigeria's total case count for 2014 remains 6. The most recent case had onset of paralysis on 24 July in Sumaila Local Government Area (LGA), southern Kano state.

Pakistan: **One new WPV1 case was reported in the past week,** in Peshawar district of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa. This most recent case had onset of paralysis on 17 March. The total number of WPV1 cases for 2015 is now 21 (and remains 306 for 2014).
