Rotary Peace Centers

- Train fellows in peace and conflict issues
- Advance knowledge and world understanding among potential world leaders
- Promote greater tolerance and cooperation among peoples



Rotary Peace Centers

- Seven university partners around the world
Incl new Uppsala Uni Sweden
- Funded through DDF, World Fund, and major restricted gifts
- Selection is on world competitive basis



Rotary Peace Centers

- 50 fellows for 2 year master's degree program
- 50 fellows for three-month certificate program
- Each class represents about 30 countries
- Master's program: minimum three years of relevant work experience
- Certificate program: minimum five years of relevant work experience



Peace Fellow applicants:

- Commitment to peace & conflict resolution
- Leadership ability
- Academic achievement
- Bachelor's degree
- Proficiency in second language
- Study in country other than their own
- Cannot be Rotarian or lineal descendent
except for Certificate course but no \$\$\$\$

Phased-out Awards

- Cultural 3-Month Ambassadorial
- Cultural 6-Month Ambassadorial
- Rotary Grants for University Teachers
- Scholarships Fund Pool for Low-Income Countries



Ambassadorial Scholarships

Currently Awarding

Duration: One academic year
(nine months of full-time study)



Ambassadorial Scholarships

What Candidates to Select?

- Scholars with an interest in humanitarian studies
Examples: health care, food production, environmental protection
- Scholars who wish to study in areas that do not normally host scholars
Examples: Africa, Brazil, Southeast Asia, Eastern Europe

Flat grant: US\$26,000 DDF
