## From the Governor's Chair

### November is Rotary Foundation Month

Hello 7190 Rotarians,

November is a noteworthy month in our calendar as it is Rotary Foundation Month, and that is the time to hold our annual District Foundation Event.

As in the past few years our event is taking place at the Cohoes Music Hall. There is a difference, however: this year we'll be presenting an original show, "Embracing Generations" with Rotary as the theme. The event date is Sunday, November 13, beginning with hospitality at 6:00 PM.

The show will honor Rotary's announcement of the Fifth Avenue of Service, New Generations. For one thing, the performers themselves will personify New Generations as they will be members of the C-R Productions young professionals acting group. Second, theater co-producer and Rotarian Tony Rivera has created a stimulating program of song and dance around the youth programs of Rotary: Youth Exchange, Interact, RYLA, Rotaract, Ambassadorial Scholars, Peace Scholars, Group Study Exchange and the Rotary Foundation.

Special recognition will also be given to new Paul Harris Fellows, whether "first-timers" or multiple awardees.

There will also be an Honorary Committee listing for contributions of \$100 or more to The Rotary Foundation, which is detailed in the Order

Form. Surely we can all benefit from the support given to making the world and our communities a better place, as we do with The Rotary Foundation.

We hope that members from each of our clubs will come together to support the Foundation and the special work of the Cohoes Music Hall. We will all enjoy Rotary as one, as we "Reach Within to Embrace Humanity."

November will also bring us the shipment of the "Rotarian Flavors of the World Cookbook." Orders must be placed by November 10 for shipment to be made prior to Thanksgiving. The cost of the book is \$12. We have now learned that the \$5 credit for Polio will go directly to the club. That means that if the club places an order for 20 books it pays \$240 – and \$100 goes toward the club's Polio Goal! If all our clubs could do that we'd be contributing over \$4000 to Polio!

Also, the cookbook is a club Speakers Gift that contains information about Rotary and is something they're likely to keep. Then add a letter thanking the speaker and inviting him or her as a guest to enjoy the fellowship of your club – and you may get a new member!

Finally, the book contains five recipes from our recipe contest last spring, so you won't want to miss that! The flyer within this Toolbox issue will give you all the information you need to place an order.

Checks will be held in a restricted account by the District Grants Chair.**

**We need ONE club that does not have a current District Simplified Grant to act as the lead club on this grant since we already have a DSG for our dictionaries. If your club can act as lead you will need to sign the DSG application as soon as we send it to you – don't hold on to it. Don't worry. Being lead club won't incur more paperwork – we will assist with that. Once the coats are here we will ask you to send a representative down to Schoharie County to help make the presentation.**

**Special Note: If more than 10 clubs contribute \$100 each or if club members wish to add to the grant that's great (make payable as above in #2). The District has increased Flood Relief grants to a maximum of \$2000 in matching funds. This is a great opportunity to help the kids in Schoharie County so let's GO!!! ## The Hudson Falls Rotary Club BOCES House Sale

For the past 30+ years the Hudson Falls Rotary Club and the WSWHE BOCES center in Hudson Falls have partnered to build a 3 bedroom 2 bath modular home. The big win for this project is for the students who learn, first hand, the skills needed to be successful in construction trades. The club pays all expenses for the house; once completed the sale of the modular home funds the next year's building and supplements scholarships to help students continue their studies.

The home has no interior finishing but is water tight and ready to be moved to a buyer's lot. This year the club has not been able to sell the home and is asking for anyone who might be interested, or know someone who is, to contact Howard Denison at 518-361-3240 for more details. \$27,000 is the low asking price.



**The Rotterdam Sunrise Rotary Club** joined the community effort to assist the victims of the flooding in two Rotterdam areas, Rotterdam Junction and Pattersonville. The club donated \$1000 worth of Mastercard Gift Cards. The cards were valued at \$50.00 each and were presented to the local fire departments for distribution to residents. Rotterdam Junction received \$700.00 worth or 14 cards while Pattersonville received 6 cards valued at \$300. Accepting the cards for the two fire departments were Shawn Taylor and Donny Rose.
