Here are a few ideas:

- 1) Share your work with each other. We seem to forget that we have a great deal to offer fellow members.
- 2) Put together a basket of business cards and give to new members.
- 3) Make a book of business cards and pass out to each member of your club.
- 4) Give members the opportunity to talk about their field, perhaps during a member profile, or during happy dollar time.

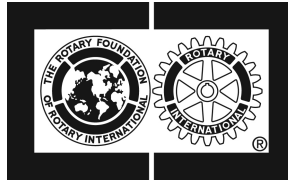
