Congratulations. You join an elite group of scholarship recipients striving to make a difference in Peace and Conflict Prevention/Resolution, and we look forward to working with you. Please note that you will be required to submit a report to your sponsoring Rotarians every 12 months for the duration of your scholarship. If your scholarship is less than 12 months, you will be required to submit a report to your sponsoring Rotarians at the end of your scholarship period. In the report,

you will provide a summary of your studies or research and how it relates to your goals in the area of focus, an account of your Rotary and community involvement, and a statement of expenses. You will also be required to send copies of receipts for expenses. Some sponsoring clubs or districts ask you to provide all receipts, while others require receipts only for expenses of US\$75 or more. Contact your Rotarian sponsors to learn what receipts you will be asked to submit.

Finally, please take note of the important information below about travel arrangements and insurance coverage.

Travel arrangements

Airfare for any travel funded by Rotary Foundation grants must be booked through Rotary International Travel Services (RITS) according to established travel policies. Please review the [Travel Arrangements](#) page on the Rotary website to learn more.

Travel insurance coverage

All those who receive funding from Rotary Foundation grants that specifically includes funds for airfare will automatically be enrolled for travel insurance that meets Rotary International's requirements when they book their airline ticket through a RITS BCD Affiliate Office. All other grantees traveling abroad on grant funds that do not include airfare or those given authorization by a RITS BCD Affiliate Office to book their own airline ticket must e-mail their completed [Insurance Form](#) to insurance@rotary.org in order to be enrolled for this insurance coverage. Any additional insurance coverage the traveler wishes to purchase will be the responsibility of the traveler. Grantees can learn more about the insurance coverage automatically provided to them as part of their award on the [Insurance](#) page of the Rotary website.
