Rotary District 7980 2015-16 Rotary Foundation GG Scholarship- Budget/Financing

The D7980 Global Grant Scholarship is \$30,000.

The Minimum GG Scholarship from TRF is \$30,000. Rotary District 7980 and The Rotary Foundation (TRF) will provide \$30,000 funding for an approved scholarship. If additional funds are required to meet the budget, candidates have various options including support from the host Rotary Club, family or friends' contributions that flow through a local Rotary Club, or financial support from the Rotary District or Club in the host city where the scholar will study. The Rotary Foundation will match host District contributions \$1.00 to \$ 1.00 and any contributions that flow through a Rotary Club \$.50 to 1.00. Contributions made personally by the applicant and funds received from scholarships other than Rotary will not be matched in any way by TRF and should be excluded from the application budget and financing plan. The following expenses are eligible to be covered by the scholarship:

- Passport/Visa
- Inoculations (but not cost of doctor appointment)
- Medical Insurance
- Travel Expenses (travel to study institution and other study-related travel; personal additional travel is not covered)
- School Supplies: books, workbooks, computer, etc.
- Tuition and other educational-related fees
- Room and Board

Most personal and other miscellaneous expenses are not eligible.

No expenses will be considered eligible if incurred before scholarship is approved by The Rotary Foundation.
