

## District “Bloggie” Video Camera

In December 2012, the district purchased five video cameras. These cameras are not the high-end, full-featured cameras but are simple hand held cameras that will allow members to easily capture video and still images for use in club and district public relations efforts. The cameras can do the following functions:



- Take varying quality of video images for posting on you-tube to creating HD quality video
- Take still images while taking videos at 5 MP quality
- Portable (size of a cell phone) and uses one-touch start and stop
- Connects to your computer via USB
- Software installer to help edit and post to youtube or facebook in the camera
- Requires you have a computer (minimum windows XP/Vista, MacOSX)

## Getting the Camera

Since we only have five, we plan to distribute the cameras to various clubs. Currently, PR committee members from West Sacramento, Granite Bay, Point West, and Natomas have access.
