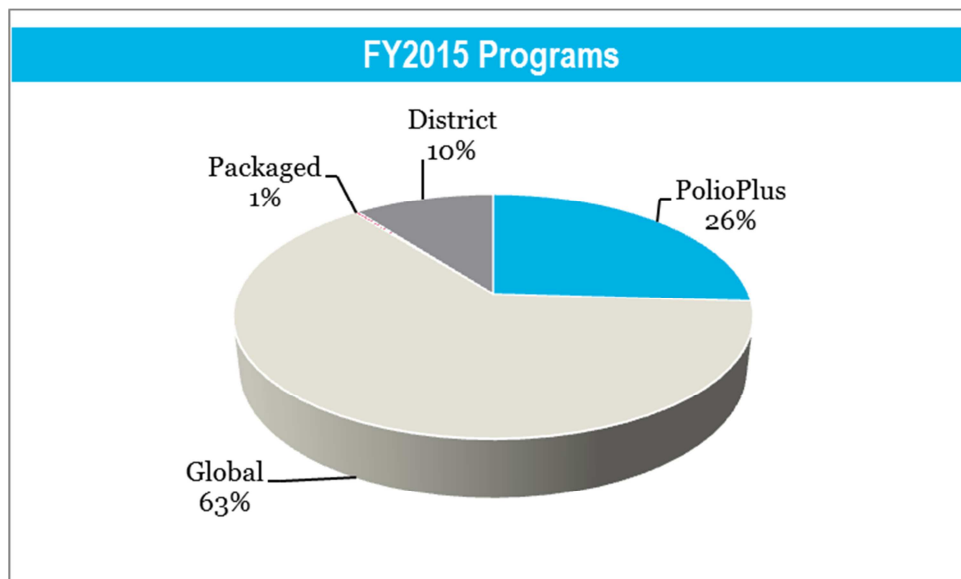
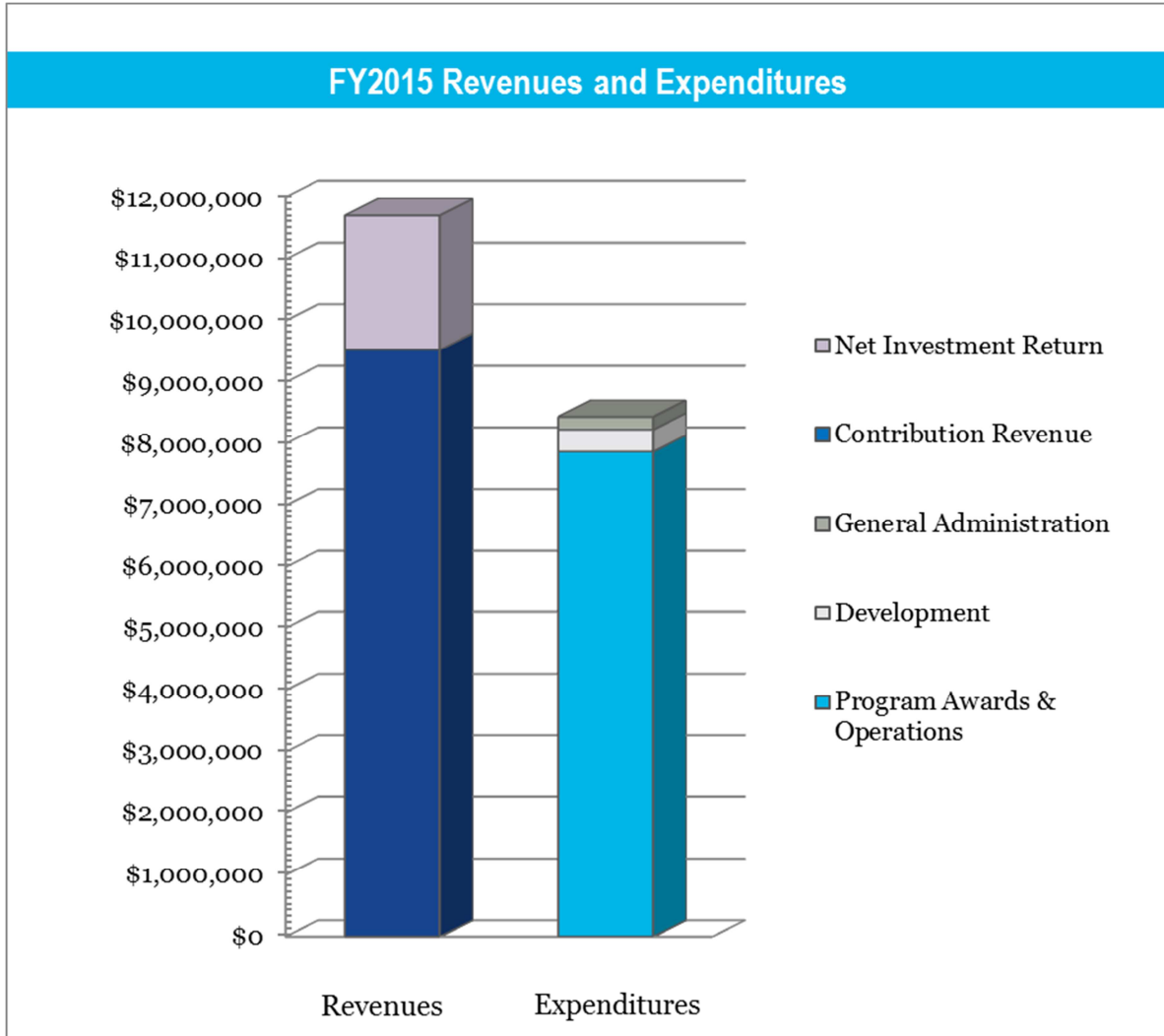


# The Rotary Foundation (Canada)

## Financial highlights for the fiscal year ended 30 June 2015



The Rotary Foundation (Canada) supports a variety of local and international charitable and social welfare programs and activities that advance world understanding, goodwill, and peace through the improvement of health, the support of education, and the alleviation of poverty.

Total expenses in the fiscal year 2014-15 were \$8,439,048. From that amount, \$7,873,964 was spent on programs.

FY2015 programs consist of the following:

- PolioPlus program provides funding, mobilizes Rotary volunteer support, and promotes polio eradication around the world;
- Global humanitarian projects and packaged projects are strategically focused, high-impact international activities with sustainable and measurable outcomes in the areas of: peace and conflict prevention /resolution, disease prevention and treatment, water and sanitation, maternal and child health, basic education and literacy, and economic and community development;
- District-level projects that enable Rotary clubs and districts to address immediate needs within their local communities and abroad.

In fiscal year 2015, The Rotary Foundation (Canada) entered into a five year grant agreement with Department of Foreign Affairs, Trade and Development (“DFATD”) on behalf of the Government of Canada to support Canadian Rotarian’s humanitarian actions and efforts to “Do Good in the World”. DFATD shall provide a grant of \$6,000,000 over five (5) fiscal years and The Rotary Foundation (Canada) shall provide a matching financial contribution of \$9,000,000 on a 3:2 matching basis.
