Who we Serve

- Children, ages 6 to 16, who face cultural and socio-economic marginalization in the areas of academic, relationship skills, peer to peer as well as social and life skills
- Live in Cambridge, Kitchener, Waterloo and the townships of Wilmot, Wellesley, Woolwich and North Dumfries

Who we Serve

- Children selected for our programs exhibit one of more of the following risk factors:
 - Poverty
 - Exposure to family violence
 - Experience with family breakdown
 - Experience of abuse
 - Learning disabilities
 - Social isolation
 - Lack of a positive role model in home
 - Immaturity and/or poor social skills

Go Girls! Healthy Bodies, Healthy Minds is designed for girls aged 12-14 and provides them with information to make informed choices about healthy, active living and supports them in dealing with the emotional, social and cultural issues they

may face.





Community Based

Big Bunch provides children and youth with mentoring support through group programming.





One-to-One mentoring matches children and youth with a caring adult mentor.





Summer Discovery provides Newcomer children and youth with the opportunity to experience a recreation and education based program within their community.


