### Who we Serve

- Children, ages 6 to 16, who face cultural and socio-economic marginalization in the areas of academic, relationship skills, peer to peer as well as social and life skills
- Live in Cambridge, Kitchener, Waterloo and the townships of Wilmot, Wellesley, Woolwich and North Dumfries

### Who we Serve

- Children selected for our programs exhibit one of more of the following risk factors:
  - Poverty
  - Exposure to family violence
  - Experience with family breakdown
  - Experience of abuse
  - Learning disabilities
  - Social isolation
  - Lack of a positive role model in home
  - Immaturity and/or poor social skills

**In-School Mentoring** provides elementary students who could benefit from extra emotional, social or academic support, with a caring adult

mentor.

# **One-to-One** mentoring matches children and youth with a caring adult mentor.






**Summer Discovery** provides Newcomer children and youth with the opportunity to experience a recreation and education based program within their community.


