Your organization will be able to replace a member as required. Should a primary or associate member leave the organization, they may request to join the club as an individual member, or they can be referred to another Rotary club.

The annual corporate fee is \$190 per member, plus annual meal costs for one member, plus weekly meal costs for additional meeting attendees.
