We broke into groups last week to identify the Strengths, Weaknesses, Opportunities and Threats that our club faces.

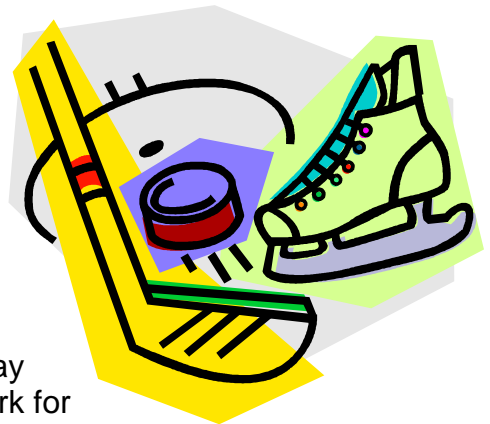
This information will be used by a committee to produce a strategic plan for the club to maintain our long term strength and stability.

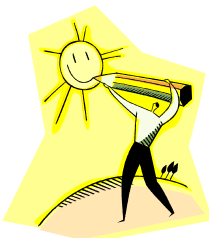
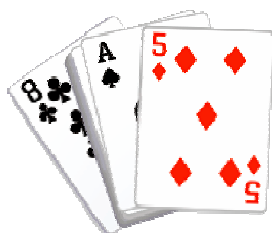


### 50/50 Card
