Application Procedure

Student information form: Please download and fill out and sign

2.

Financial Need:

Please provide your parents Notice of Assessment for past years. (e.g. applying in 2016, please provide 2013 and 2014 since 2015 may not be prepared.

3.

Nomination Letters:

Written by a person of the candidate's choice at your current school who is a teacher or an administrator. Effective nominations should demonstrate the nominee's accomplishments with concrete examples. All letters, which must include signatures.

4.

Academic Performance:

You must be in good standing academically with a B (70%) average grade or higher at your current school. Please provide transcripts for all available grades from the first term/semester of your current year.

5.

Volunteerism & Social Responsibility:

Please outline your volunteer experiences and your engagement in socially responsible activities or services. (Please include number hours spent in these activities) <u>Volunteering</u>: The policy or practice of giving one's time or talents for charitable, educational, or other worthwhile activities, especially in one's community.

<u>Social Responsibility:</u> Enabling the right actions, doing actions that are good for community and society at large.

6.

Essay:

Please write or type 500 words or two pages doubled spaced font size 12 describing the following:

"If I had \$10,000 to spend, what would be the most important cause in your community to help and why?"
