

Chinatown has come a long way since the days when the Chinese immigrants made this area their home. Filled with a wide range of shops and eateries, bustling with colorful and exciting activities set against a backdrop of rich history and heritage, a trip to Chinatown is not to be missed — especially in the evening when the area comes to life. Wander through the narrow lanes of the Night Market and test your bargaining skills against the street vendors selling anything from souvenirs to leather goods. After dinner at a local Chinese restaurant, you will take the coach down to Bugis Village. The highlight of the evening will be a trishaw ride that will take you past the vibrant Bugis Village and the bustling streets of Little India. Hop onto a bumboat at Clarke Quay for a cruise along the Singapore River to see Singapore lit up at night, showcasing beautifully restored shophouses, modern skyscrapers, in the financial district, colonial buildings, and the iconic Merlion statue. After dinner at a local Chinese restaurant, we will coach down to Bugis Village. The highlight of the evening is a trishaw ride that will take you past the vibrant Bugis Village and the bustling streets of Little India. Hop onto a bumboat at Clarke Quay for a cruise along the Singapore River to see Singapore lit up at night, showcasing beautifully restored shophouses, modern skyscrapers of the financial district, colonial buildings and the iconic Merlion statue.

DAY 05 : May 26, 2024. SINGAPORE (B/-/-)

This morning after breakfast, head on a city tour of Singapore. Drive through the civic and colonial districts of the city before making a stop at Merlion, an icon symbol of Singapore — a lion-headed figure with the body of a fish. Take photos of the monument and enjoy the views of Marina Bay. From there you will visit the Thian Hock Keng — the oldest Chinese temple in Singapore. Next, enter the district of Little India, famous for its vibrant colors and the scent of joss sticks, jasmines, and spices. The final stop on this tour will be the National Orchid Gardens where you may see the sprawling displays of different types of orchids. Spend the rest of the day at leisure.

Overnight in Singapore

Optional: Half day visit to Jurong Bird Park: CAD 160 per person based on Min. of 2 pax

Immerse in the symphon of colors and nature's music at the Asia's largest bird park. Feast your eyes on some of the world's most brilliantly coloured birds, amongst wetland vegetation and crimson blooms. Hornbills, spoonbills and other fascinating birds of Asia await you in the tranquil paradise of tall bamboo grooves and paddy terraces. You also get to see the flightless birds at the Penguin Cove, the Mysterious Papua from New Guinea, over 80 species of African origin at Nyngwe Forest, over 30 species of Australian outback apart from the birds from Amazon, all in their natural environment recreated here.

Optional: Evening Night Safari at the Zoological Park : CAD 140 per person based on Min. of 2 pax

The world's first nocturnal park lets you experience night life as experience in a forest. Hop on the open sides tram and journey through world's 06 geographical region. Go down under to the natural wonders and wildlife of Australia, New Zealand and New Guinea, Discover a unique crossroad of Africa and Asia. You get to see Asian Elephants, Malayan Tapir or take the Fishing Cat trail and discover some of the skilled hunters and specialised oddballs like the giant anteater, armadillo and pangolin.

DAY 06 : May 27, 2024. SINGAPORE (B/-/-)

Another day at leisure to relax and explore Singapore at your own pace. Overnight in Singapore

Optional: Excursion to Sentosa Island Resort : CAD 160 per person based on Min. of 2 pax

Enjoy an excursion to Singapore's most popular Islands, Sentosa, known for its tropical beach and funpark. Enjoy a sky tram ride to reach the island, providing with some of the most stunning views of the surroundings. Visit Sioso fort, Singapore's only coastal Fort to be preserved, accessibly by a 11storey high skywalk. See the Sentosa Skyjet, at 80mts, it is worlds tallest fountain, Air combat, a virtual reality experience of

flying an aircraft and actually indulging in the combat, Enjoy thrilling rides at the eco cove waterpark or visit the Dolphin park. You can try out your hand at the varied cuisine available or just relax by the beach side. Other attractions included Madame Tussauds wax museum and the signature Wings of time musical fountain show in the evening.

DAY 07 : May 28, 2024. SINGAPORE (B/-/-)

Enjoy your day at leisure. You may choose to explore Sentosa Island, head on a Bumboat ride on the Singapore River, shop along Orchard Road, explore the splendid Gardens by the Bay, take in the views at the Marina Bay Sands Skypark, discover the Singapore National Museum, explore Kampong Glam (a Malaysian enclave), or enjoy drinks and dining at Clarke Quay, Boat Quay, or Robertson Quay. You may also treat yourself to one of the Michelin star restaurants in Singapore. Overnight in Singapore

Optional: Full day excursion to Universal Studios : CAD 140 per person based on Min. of 2 pax

Visit Southeast Asia's first and the only theme park by Universal studio for a day full of fun and excitement. Enjoy adrenaline pumping rides, interactive shows and a wide variety of exciting attractions based on the blockbuster movies and television series. Enjoy one of the 06 themed zones including the Hollywood, New Yorl, Sci fi city, Ancient Egypt, The Lost World and Far Far away. Visit the S.E.A Aquarium, one of the worlds



DAY 01: PHUKET ARRIVAL

Welcome to Thailand! Upon arrival at Phuket International Airport, you will be met and transferred to your hotel for check-in. Enjoy the day at leisure. You may explore the breathtaking beaches of Phuket.

DAY 02: PHUKET (B/-/-)

Enjoy a delicious breakfast and spend your day at leisure. There are plenty of memorable things to do in Phuket. The island itself boasts a beautiful historical town, breathtaking viewpoints, and iconic cultural attractions. Perhaps you may be interested in our optional tours. Overnight in Phuket

Optional: Khaosok Jungle Discovery (Hiking & Canoeing) [Minimum 2 Pax]: CAD 190 per person

FREQUENCY: Wednesday TIMING: 0700-1900

NOTES: SIC tour with min. 2 persons

Prepare for an exhilarating adventure through the Khao Sok Jungle. This will be a fun and educational experience. Jungle Hiking on foot in Khaosok National Park, you will come across enchanting plants, flowers, butterflies, birds, squirrels, reptiles, and more. A self-guided nature trail will explain the many ways native plants were used throughout history (approx. 3-hrs.). Canoe silently down the Sok River in a stable boat paddled by an experienced guide. Keep your eyes open for birds and many small species local to the land along with large limestone cliffs. After the long walk, you may relax at Rommanee Hot Spring; try the self-foot-spa or whole body before you return to Phuket.

OR

Optional: Phuket Fantasea Show Including Dinner: CAD 99 per person

FREQUENCY: Daily TIMING: 1830-2300

Inspired by Thailand's rich and exotic heritage, Phuket FantaSea not only showcases the beauty and charm of Thailand — you will discover the Las Vegas-style theatrical show with state-of-the-art technology and special effects enhancing the grace and beauty of Thai mythology.

NOTES: Private tour with English speaking guide only Wander through the Sino-Portuguese center of traditional Phuket. There is no better way to take in the magnificent architecture of Phuket than by foot. Crafted and designed under the old and still practiced measures,

Phuket Town is a breathtaking area. Pay attention to the detail in design as you pass through side streets and historic buildings. Outside its rich cultural heritage and quaint colonial mansions, Phuket Town is a true melting pot of street-side eateries and stalls that serve only the best. With a visit to a historic Chinese temple and delicious donner on Rang Hills, you will experience a different side of Phuket, hidden from tourist trails.

Optional: Coral Island by Speedboat Including Lunch: CAD 80 per person

FREQUENCY: Daily TIMING: 0800-1600

NOTES: SIC tour with English speaking guide. Pick up and drop off from Maikhao, Naiyang, Naithorn and Ao Por are available on request at a surcharge.

Enjoy a 15 minute-speedboat trip to Coral Island (Koh Hey). Discover the white sandy beach, give snorkeling a try, and go swimming in the turquoise water. A variety of sea activities (optional) such as sea walking, diving, parasailing, and banana boats will be available. Enjoy lunch at the restaurant. In the afternoon you may enjoy leisure time to relax on the beach.

OR

Optional: Phang Nga Bay by Speedboat Inclusive of Lunch: CAD 150 per person

FREQUENCY: Daily TIMING: 0730-1730

NOTES: *SIC tour with English speaking guide min. 2

Your magical full-day Thai island adventure will start when your friendly local guide picks you up from your hotel in Phuket. Leaving for Koh Panak around 9 AM, you will travel to the island by speedboat. Explore the mangrove cave or admire the exotic wildlife as you wander around the island. Next, you will travel to Khao Tapu, famous for its role in the James Bond film "The Man with the Golden Gun". For this reason, the island is often referred to as 'James Bond Island'. Here, you may visit the Leaning Rock (Khao Ping Gun), a 164-foot behemoth situated atop other rocks, or wander around the mangrove swamp. A delicious lunch buffet will be served at Koh Panyee around 12:15 PM, known for its homes built on stilts in the water. After lunch, you may go canoeing through a sea cave and wander through a mangrove forest on Tham Lod. Upon reaching Naka Island, you may choose to swim, sunbathe, or relax on the beach. From here you will leave around 4 PM and arrive back in Phuket between 4:30 and 4:45 PM. Your guide will take you to your hotel at the end of the day.

DAY 03, FRI: PHUKET – PHI PHI (B/-/-)

After breakfast, you will be transferred to Rassada Pier in Phuket for a ferry to Phi Phi Island, one of the most beautiful island groups in Thailand. Phi Phi is famous for its limestone cliffs rising out of the emerald-green waters, white powdery beaches, and coral reefs with diving and snorkeling activities. A two-hour ferry ride will take you through the Viking Cave. Upon arrival at Tonsai Pier, you will need to pay an entrance fee (20 BAHT) and then transfer to your hotel. Spend the rest of the day at leisure. There are lots of things to do on Phi Phi Island to make the most of your time. From day activities involving the sun and sand to nighttime adventures involving fire shows and dancing on the beach, Phi Phi Island has something to offer for everyone. Overnight in Phi Phi



DAY 04, SAT: PHI PHI (B/-/-)

Today you may enjoy a day at leisure. Stroll along the beach, go sunbathing or check out some of the water sports available.

Overnight in Phi Phi

DAY 05, SUN: PHI PHI – KRABI (B/-/-)

Spend your morning at leisure. You will be able to store your luggage at the hotel upon check out before being transferred back to Tonsai Pier later this afternoon. Prepare for a ferry ride to Krabi. The ferry will depart Tonsai Pier at 3:30 PM and arrive at Ao Nang, Krabi at 5:00 PM. Upon arrival in Krabi, you will be transferred to the resort.

DAY 06, MON: KRABI (B/-/-)

After breakfast at the hotel, spend your day at leisure. There is no place on earth quite like Krabi, one of Thailand's tourist jewels. With its jagged karst limestone islands rising from the azure sea, pure white beaches, and exotic temples on land, Krabi is a fascinating place to discover. From ancient Buddhist caves and seafront restaurants to water sports, golf, and vibrant nightlife, the coast around Krabi can offer a little bit of everything.


Optional: 4 Island Trip by Speed Boat Incl. Lunch: CAD 80 Per person on S.I.C Basis

FREQUENCY: Daily TIMING: 0900 to 1600

NOTES: SIC tour with a minimum of 2 people.

English-speaking guide only

This tour will take you to unique limestone islands by speedboat. Swimming, snorkeling, sunbathing, exploring, and photography are the main activities to enjoy. Expect plenty of sunshine, a rich variety of corals and fish, crystal-clear water, and white powdery beaches lined with



coconut palms. You will have a picnic lunch (rice box provided) on an island beach. There will also be open water snorkeling stops — but do not expect to see much in the way of marine life. This trip is more about the beaches, with lots of white sand and excellent photo opportunities. We will stop at Chicken Island, which got its name from a bizarre rock formation resembling the head of a chicken. One end of the island consists of majestic cliffs, while the other end boasts beautiful beaches along a peninsula. This peninsula gets flooded at high tide, creating a small island. At low tide you may walk between the Tup Islets and Chicken Island. The itinerary will vary according to the tides so that you arrive at the sandbank as close to low tide as possible.

Optional: Krabi Rainforest Discovery Tour Incl. Lunch: CAD 90 Per person on S.I.C Basis

FREQUENCY: Daily

TIMING: 09:00 to 16:00

NOTES: SIC tour with minimum 2 persons, English

speaking guide only

Prepare for a fun and educational day at the Khao Nor Chu Chi National Park. You may admire and appreciate the incredible gifts of nature as you enjoy a day in the park. Begin your trip with a visit to the thermal spring pools nestled in the rainforest. Take a dip in the hot pools. From there you will travel to a rubber plantation to see how rubber is tapped from the trees and produced into latex sheets. This age-old method stands the test of time as the trunk of the tree is carved to let the sap flow freely into a container. Take a jungle walk in one of the last lowland rainforests in Thailand and learn about the biodiversity of the area. Visit Emerald Pool for a swim in the clear blue waters before you end your day at Tiger Cave Temple. This unique forest temple boasts trees that are more than 1,000 years old. From here you will discover the best views looking out over Krabi. A picnic lunch will be included.

Optional: Khao Sok Nature Tour Incl. Lunch: CAD 110 Per person on S.I.C Basis

FREQUENCY: Daily

TIMING: 08:30 to 17:30

NOTES: SIC tour with minimum 2 persons, English

Elephants and Rainforests — both very special but sadly endangered! Take the opportunity to see them at least once in your life. Cross over the rainforest-covered by mountains to Khao Sok. Canoe down the Sok River in inflatable canoes with a guide to do the paddling for you. Pass limestone mountains covered in Jungle vegetation along the banks of the river. Birds and monkeys live in this area. You will discover some of the most beautiful natural scenery in Southern Thailand; what better way to see it than from a Canoe? In the afternoon you will arrive at an elephant camp. Explore the jungle by an elephant! Lunch will be included.

DAY 07, TUE: KRABI - PHUKET -TORONTO (B/-/-)

Today you will be transferred to Krabi International Airport or overland to Phuket International Airport to check-in for your onward flight.
