Some of the Important Rules and Conditions of the Exchange

Violations will result in student's immediate return home at the students expense.

- 1) District 7080 neither sponsors nor accepts students who smoke or vape.
- 2) The student must attend school regularly and make an honest effort.
- 3)
- Obey the Laws of the Host Country. If found guilty of violating any law, the student can not expect assistance from their sponsors. Student will be returned home when authorities release him/her.
- 4) The student is not allowed to possess or use illegal drugs. Medicine prescribed by a physician and legal in host country is allowed.
- 5) The student is not authorized to operate a motorized vehicle, or to participate in driver education programs.
- 6) The illegal drinking of alcoholic beverages is expressly forbidden. If the host family offers a student an alcoholic drink, it is permissible to accept it under their supervision in their home.
- 7) Unauthorized travel is not allowed. Students must follow the travel rules of the Host District.
- 8)

The student must be covered by a health and life insurance policy agreeable to the Sponsor and Host District.

9) Duration of the exchange is expected to be 11 to 12 months. Travel arrangements are to be confirmed with the sponsor and host district.

The student must abide by the rules and conditions of exchange of the Sponsor District 7080 & the Host District. Exchange Rules may vary according to each district.
