Rotary International Annual Foundation Giving Campaign

- In late 2002, a District 7080 initiative to have all clubs and its members become a **Rotary Foundation Sustaining Member**
- This is an individual who contributes US\$100 or more per year to the Annual Programs Fund.

Rotary International Annual Foundation Giving Campaign

- Your Board of Directors decided to support this initiative by providing a financial contribution of up to 50%.

I.e. For every \$100 Cdn dollars donated by a member, the board provide an additional \$50 Cdn dollars to the Rotary Foundation

- At the end of the 2003-04 Rotary year, The District Governor of 7080 was proud to announce that 100% of all clubs donated to the Rotary Foundation

Rotary International Annual Foundation Giving Campaign

- A **Paul Harris Fellow** is an individual who contributes or in whose name is contributed US\$1,000 to the Annual Programs Fund.
- Each Paul Harris Fellow is presented with a commemorative certificate, pin and medallion.

Rotary International Annual Foundation Giving Campaign

A Multiple Paul Harris Fellow:

- For additional gifts totaling US\$1,000 or more, a Paul Harris Fellow is recognized as a Multiple Paul Harris Fellow; and who may also choose to honour someone else as a Paul Harris Fellow; and is eligible to receive a Multiple Paul Harris Fellow pin with additional sapphire or ruby stones.
