The World Health Organization Declares Africa Polio-Free





I have cancelled the AUTO Deposit option for e-transfers but you can do INTERAC e-transfers for Happy Bucks and Dues etc.

Why cancel Auto-Deposit?

- In auto deposit, payee is same (john.izard@bell.net) but it does not require that you generate a security question when you issue/ transfer money. It did go automatically directly into our Club's RBC Administration (General) account which was nice but ... the problem is the bank statement doesn't show your name (I do receive a warning automatic email that you have made a deposit but this is only a separate email.

Switching back to INTERAC system

- By cancelling the auto-deposit, you default to INTERAC system where again my email address is PAYEE (<u>john.izard@bell.net</u>) and it will ask you to come up with a security question and answer. I MUST get it correctly to avoid rejection (and would likely create an NSF equivalent rejection fee to you). **As such, can you please standardize your security question and answer as follows:**

Security Question = what is our club name?

Answer = **Heartlake** (exactly in this form including capitals (1))

The cost is no different (usually included in your monthly bank account fees) but your <u>name shows up on the banking statement</u> making my life, Lynda Noll's and Carol MacMurchy's far simpler for tracking..
